The Cooperative will construct, own and maintain all electrical equipment up to the meter location in accordance with the following requirements:	
 New Service Fee: A nonrefundable fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus applicable sales tax shall be paid by the Applicant and must accompany this agreement. If you are unsure of the sales tax amount, please call the cooperative. Re-application and fee are necessary if the Applicant does not proceed with the project within one year. Monthly Minimum Charge: The Applicant shall guarantee payment of the minimum monthly charge, as established in the applicable retail rate, for a period of sixty (60) consecutive months. The cooperative may require this minimum payment be paid in advance if it believes circumstances are such that the service may not remain on a continuing basis or have limited electrical usage. Line Extension A line extension charge may be required due to distance, significant investment and risk the Cooperative makes for line extensions. The line extension charge shall be paid by the Applicant prior to the start of construction. Member Application Form: A signed member application form is required to become a member and receive service. This application allows the privileges of voting and participation in the Cooperative's activities. Right-of-way Clearance: The Applicant shall provide and pay the cost for the initial right-of-way clearing for the line extension done in accordance with the Cooperative's specifications. Construction of Service: The line extension shall be scheduled for construction after the following is completed: A. All necessary payments and documents have been received by the Cooperative. B. Right-of-way clearing completed and accepted by the Cooperative. Wiring affidavit received by the Cooperative. Ownership: It is understood and agreed between the parties hereto and expressly granted by the Member that the title and ownership in and to all material and equipment up to and ending at the Memb
